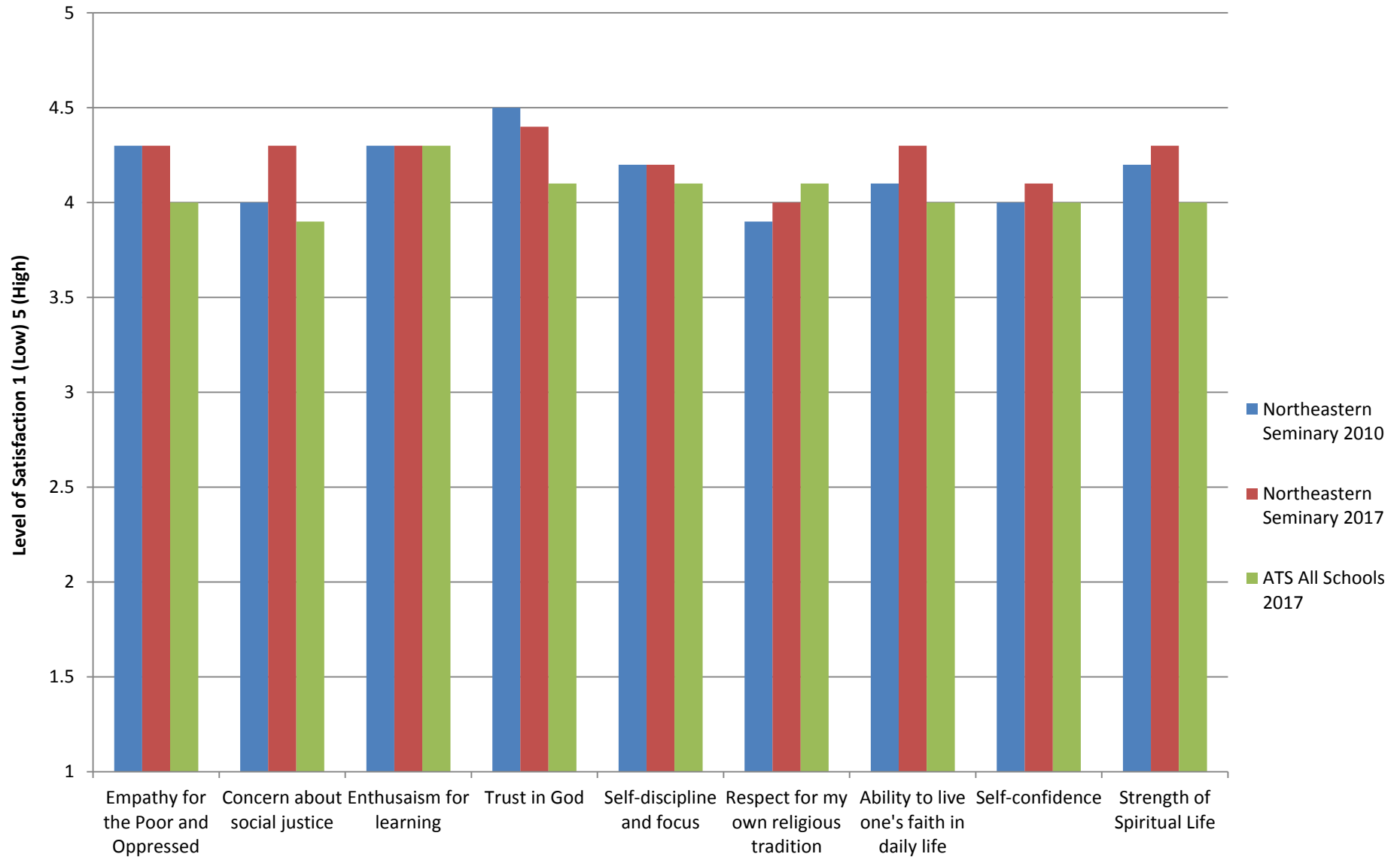

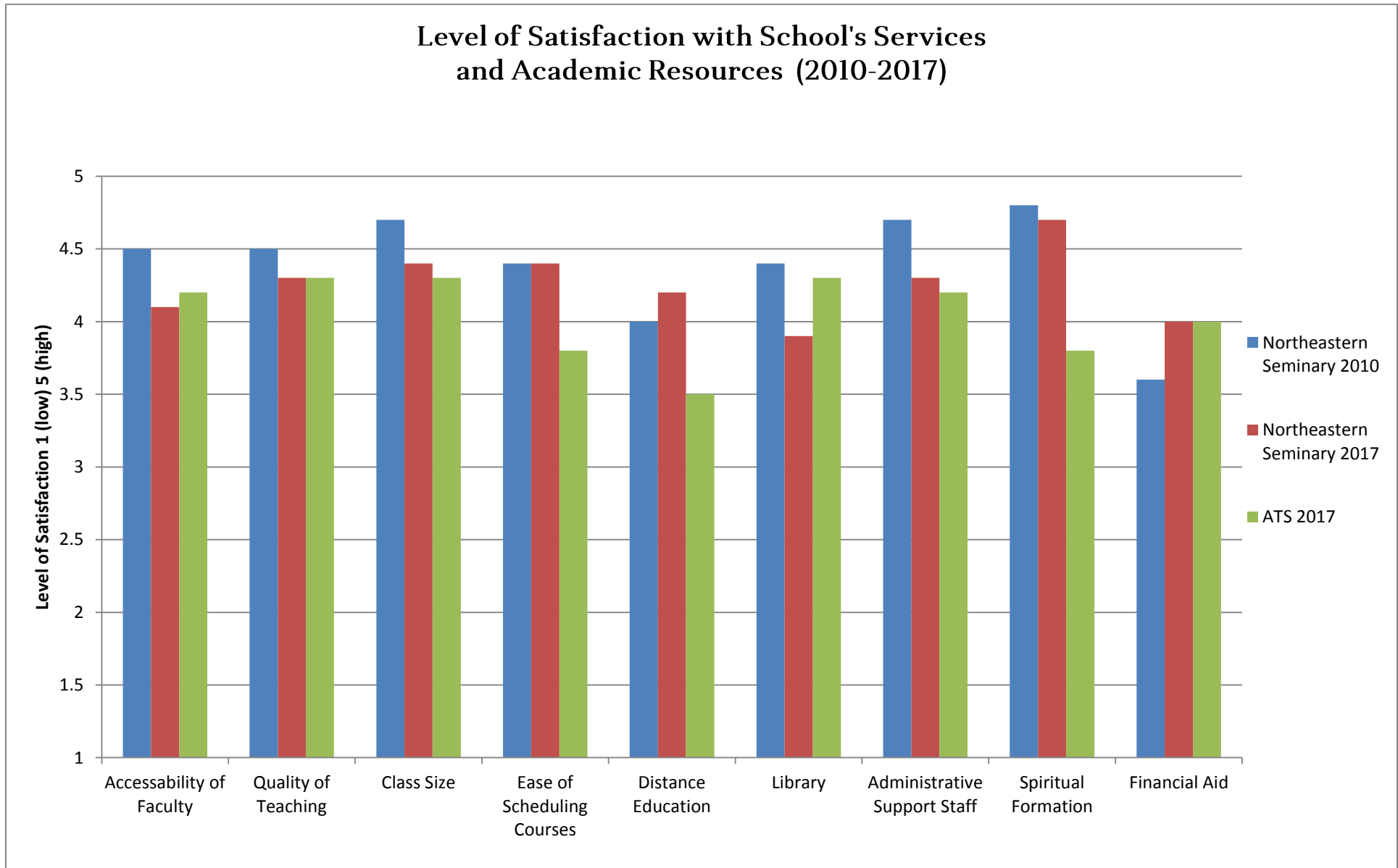
### Overall Experience During Theological Program (2010-2017)

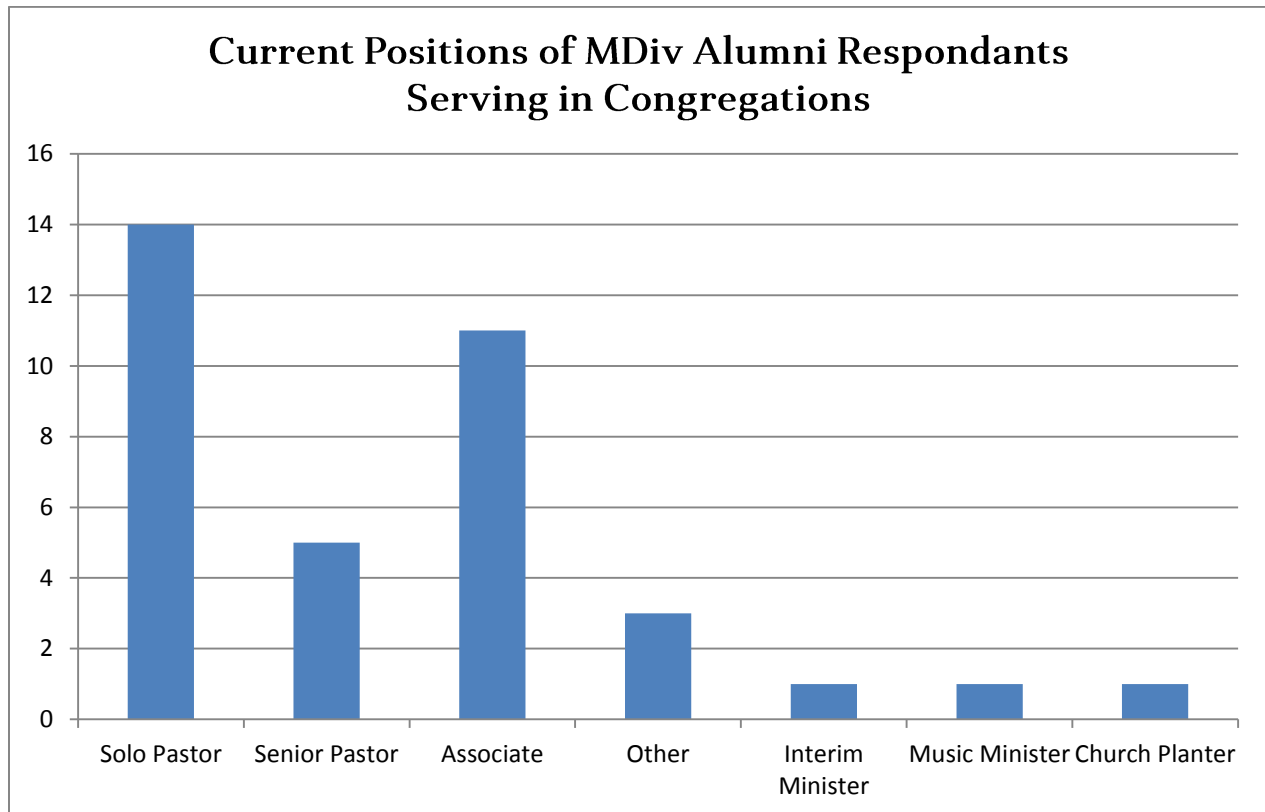
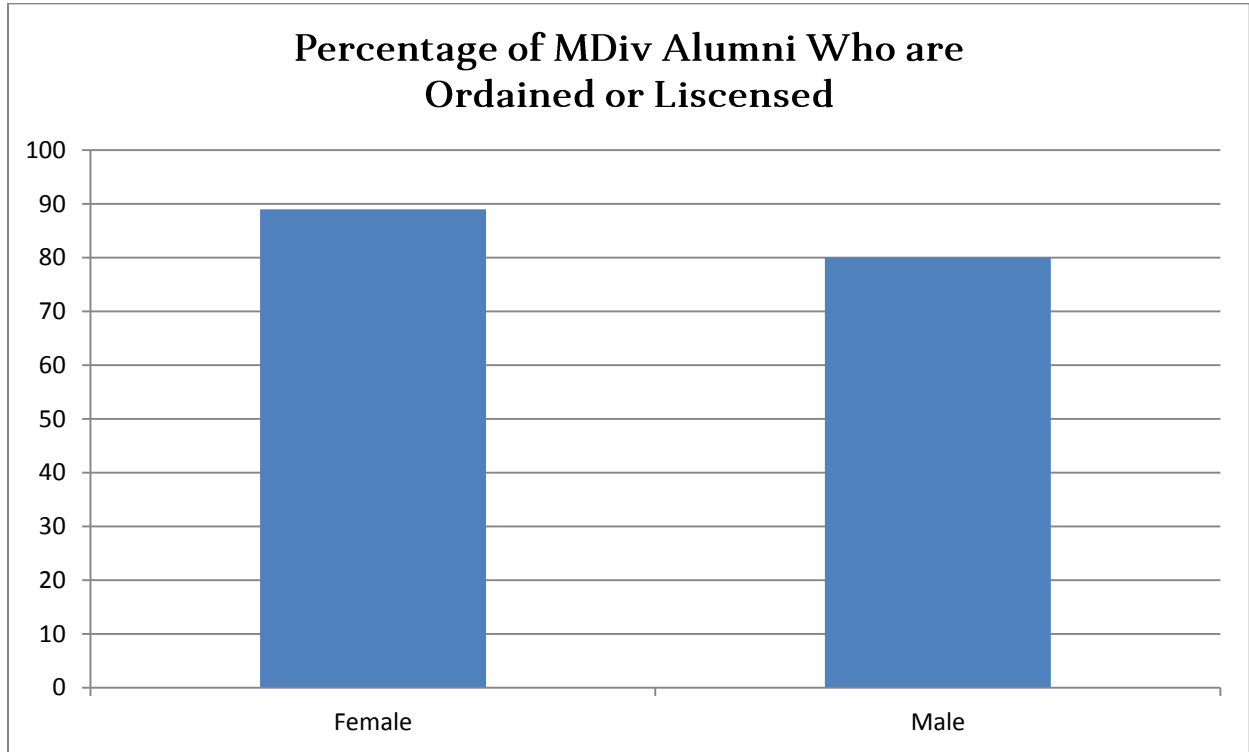


### Measures of Personal Growth after Theological Program (2010-2017)
