Scholarships

Northeastern Seminary Scholarship: 25% reduction in tuition

This scholarship is awarded annually and is based on financial need of the student as determined by Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) eligibility. The FAFSA can be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Please indicate the Seminary's school code of G34194. The FAFSA must be updated each academic year.

Northeastern Seminary Presidential Scholarship: 50% reduction in tuition

This scholarship is awarded annually and is based on evidence of academic strength in previous work and potential for contribution to ministry development. Selection is based on content and evidence provided in admissions materials/essays. Special attention is given to past academic performance and ecclesiastical recommendations. Because this scholarship recognizes academic strength, continuation of the award throughout the doctor of ministry program is contingent upon maintaining at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA each term.

If a student qualifies for more than one level of scholarship, the single highest level will be awarded.
